## **UNI DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR AWARD 2019-2020**

**Distinguished Scholar nomination materials must include** the following. Items 1 through 6 must be submitted electronically.

- 1.) A signed cover page.
- 2.) Letter of nomination by the nominator.
- 3.) A complete and current vita, **limited to scholarly record**.
- 4.) Personal statement by the nominee discussing his/her record of scholarly or creative achievement (**not to exceed 2 typed pages single-spaced, 12 inch font Times New Roman, one inch margin**). These accomplishments should represent at least five years of outstanding achievement.
- 5.) Two more letters of support (in addition to nomination letter). Do not exceed the number requested. Please have letters sent directly to the Graduate College.
- 6.) A selection of a maximum of 10 items sent electronically: books, articles or appropriate examples of creative work must be submitted to supplement the written narrative. (one item= one book or one article or one creative work)

**One copy of all nomination materials must be received in the Graduate College Office on Friday, January 31, 2020 by 4:30 p.m.** The Distinguished Scholar Award will be presented at the Annual Graduate Faculty Meeting in April.
